

Seattle Sailing Club Community Safety Protocols

While Seattle Sailing Club will be keeping up with cleanings, we ask that our members do the same to protect the community. Please follow the below protocols:

REVIEW NEW & CONTINUING CLUB POLICIES

- **Members will need to sign the online [Member Uniform Assumption of Risk Waiver](#).** This is required prior to your first reservation. (New Policy)
- **All membership levels are allowed 1 future day sail reservation** in the books at a time per membership. You're welcome to reserve a boat to take out the same-day, but you must reserve it only for the same day you're taking it out. (Continuing policy)
- **Life Jackets.** Have life jackets for yourself and your guests. SSC life jackets will not be available for members or guests. (New policy)
- **Running late for your reservation.** If you are running more than 15 minutes late for your reservation, give us a call. If you are 30 minutes late and have not called, your reservation will be canceled. (New policy)
- **Cancel your reservation** if you or any of your guests are experiencing cold or flu-like symptoms.
- Remove all personal belongings, trash (head & salon), food, usage reports, keys, ice, etc before leaving the boat. (Continuing policy)
- **Usage Reports are required to be submitted via email or our new digital [Small Boat Usage Report](#) and [Big Boat Usage Reports](#).** (New Policy)
 - If you would prefer to write-up the usage report and email it, you're welcome to do so - please thoroughly and legibly complete the report and email a photo of the front & back to info@seattlesailing.com.
 - If a usage report is not submitted within 24 hours of your sail, we will follow up and if we don't receive a usage report, we will suspend your reservation ability.
- **After-hours reservations (New policy)**
 - Same-day after-hours reservations (sails after 5:00pm), need to be reserved before 4:00pm to ensure we are aware of the reservation and can prep your boat. If this is not possible, please call to notify us of your reservation.

- **Holding Tanks.** If the head is used, you are responsible for pumping it out after your day sail. (New Policy)
- **Dock concierges are not available** for docking assistance, rescues, or in-person troubleshooting. (New Policy)
 - If you are stranded or in need of a tow, contact Vessel Assist. Members will be financially responsible for vessel assistance or any other towing expenses.
- **Follow the [docking arrangement](#).** Boats have been strategically placed to ensure clean boats are not contaminated and dirty boats aren't used. **Docking in the Wrong Slip fee** will be heavily enforced. (Continuing Policy)
- **The J/80 you reserve is the J/80 you will sail.** Please take note of the name. (New Policy)
- **Spinnakers are not** currently available. (New Policy)
- Wear gloves and a mask when cleaning your boat. Exterior and interior cleaning are more important than ever. Please help us keep the community and our staff healthy.
- **Wash your hands** often and for 20 seconds.

Checking In for Your Reservation

- A 6ft table is set-up at the entrance to the office. Please knock for assistance and do not enter the office. We will come to you.
 - **Wear a mask** when checking in, on the dock ramps, and on the dock.
- Adhere to **social distancing** around the promenade, outside of the office, and on the dock.
- **Paperwork and transactions will be completed online.** We will not be accepting cash.

- Olympic Club day sails will be automatically charged to the card on file.

SUGGESTED BOAT CAPACITIES

In Phase 2 of the WA Phase Approach to Reopening, gatherings of 5 people (outside of your household) per week are permitted in outdoor recreation. Our members are responsible for adhering to the Governor's orders when using our fleet. Please take our suggested boat capacities when planning your sail.

Under 30' boats

- 4 people residing within the same household
- 2 people not living within the same household

30'+ Boats

- 5 people residing within the same household
- 3 people not living within the same household
