Racing Events

DURATION: 4 Hours

This popular program is ideal for organizations looking to provide a unique and memorable experience for small to large groups. Under expert instruction and supervision, your group will form into individual sailing crews of 4 – 6 people on each boat. Each experienced instructor/skipper will guide and encourage individual crew members to take an active part in the steering and sailing of the yachts.

The experience creates the opportunity for groups to take on a dynamic challenge, develop new skills and strengthen team spirit - All while having fun on the beautiful Puget Sound.

BOATS: 32' - 45' sailboats

GROUP SIZE: 3 - 50 (minimum 3)

BOXED LUNCH: \$30/person (minimum 5 lunches)

Fun Sail (3-hours) - \$150/person

Destinations (4-hours) - \$175/person
